- 2. Commercial projects with vehicular traffic or sites with poor soil conditions may require thicker gravel base, concrete curb edge restraint, and/or sand subbase.
- 3. Adequate surface drainage should be provided to prevent ponded water.
- 4. This section is not intended for permeable pavement applications.
